

EIGHTEENTH ANNUAL PESCADO GRANDE BAY AND GULF FISHING TOURNAMENT TOURNAMENT RULES

1. All boats must check in at Froggies in Port O'Conner or the City Harbor in Seadrift on Saturday morning between 4:30 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. for offshore and 5:00 a.m. and 7 a.m. for bay.
2. All persons in boat must be wearing bracelets issued at registration indicating paid entrance into tournament.
3. Bay division-Limit 4 persons to boat. Offshore Division-No limit to number of registered fishermen.
4. Boats must fly their tournament flags and may be subject to inspection by tournament officials.
5. All federal, state, and tournament rules will be abided by including a valid fishing license. Valid fishing license must be available for inspection at time of weigh-in.
6. NO OVERSIZED TAGGED REDFISH OR STINGRAYS WILL BE ALLOWED.
7. Fish must be caught on Saturday, June 28, 2008 between the hours of 5:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Setting trout lines and fishing prior to the tournament are prohibited. Anglers must be in line with fishing certificate to weigh in their fish no later than 6:00 p.m.
8. Fishermen on boat can string each others' fish together; however, this must be done before entering the weigh-in line. No sorting or substitution in the weigh-in line.
9. All fish must be caught by pole or rod & reel in adherence to State law.
10. All fish submitted for weigh-in must be in a fresh, edible condition. Spoiled, pale, gilled, marred, or ALTERED fish not in its natural state will be disqualified.
11. In the event of a tie by weight, length determines the winner.
12. An individual fish may not be entered in more than one category to win.
13. Only one entry per category per boat.
14. All fish entered will be marked by the weigh master.
15. Every fish that makes it to the Leader Board is subject to dissection.
16. Teams are subject to disqualification from the tournament in the event of any violation of tournament rules or suspected foul play, to include the weighing in of fish which appear to be caught prior to the day of the tournament. Likewise, teams may be subject to polygraph at the discretion of the rules and regulation committee.
17. **ALL DECISIONS OF TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS ARE FINAL. NO APPEALS.**
18. In case of tournament cancellation, entry fee will be donated to The Harbor Children's Alliance and Victim Center. Tournament will not be rescheduled.
19. To receive winnings, Social Security number must accompany WV9 form provided by The Harbor.
